 - Alternatively, use these for an additional jackpot round worth points or prizes!
 - Additional instructions included on the relevant page (Page 11)

HOW TO USE YOUR QUIZ

- Print your pack!
 - You will need as many copies of the answer/handout sheets as you have players/teams – and 1 copy of the question/answer sheets for you/the host. Alternatively, you can keep the questions digital to reduce your paper use!
- Gather your quiz-goers and give them each a copy of the first sheet (with rounds 1, 3, and 5 printed) - then get to reading out questions!



- You can ask your players to mark their own sheets, swap and mark, or mark them yourself.
- After rounds 1 and 3, give your players one of the two handout rounds (2 and 4 respectively) for them to work through at their own pace.
- The fifth round works the same as a normal quiz round – with a twist! Each specialist round comes with unique instructions – in this sample, Make the Connection tasks players with finding a common theme among their answers for bonus points
